

## Cabot Corporation Selected as a Bronze Winner for the Ninth Annual Team Massachusetts Economic Impact Awards

## Winners selected based on job growth, expansion and investment, and community involvement

BOSTON--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Oct. 29, 2012-- <u>Cabot Corporation</u> (NYSE: CBT) has been named as a bronze winner for the Team Massachusetts Economic Impact Awards, awarded annually by MassEcon (Massachusetts Alliance for Economic Development). The awards celebrate companies that have made an outstanding contribution to the Massachusetts economy. Cabot Corporation earned this prestigious award due to its recent \$10 million capacity expansion project at its Haverhill, Massachusetts, inkjet facility. This expansion resulted in a 30 percent increase in production staff and doubles the production capacity of Cabot's <a href="CAB-O-JET">CAB-O-JET</a> small molecule color and polymer-attached pigment dispersion lines. The project is instrumental in supporting Cabot's growth in the emerging office segment of inkjet printing, as well as the commercial inkjet printing market.

"We are honored to be recognized for impacting the local Massachusetts economy through our plant expansion and job creation in Haverhill," said Patrick Prevost, President and Chief Executive Officer, Cabot Corporation. "Massachusetts has been our home for 130 years and it's been a great place for us to grow our businesses and attract some of the best talent. We look forward to further growth as we identify new opportunities to meet future customer and market needs."

"The key to our economic recovery is innovation, and these Team Massachusetts Impact Award winners exemplify that innovative spirit," said Greg Bialecki, the Secretary of Housing and Economic Development.
